Supply List

1. Print the 8.5" x 11" pdf design(s) you are sent: black/white, print on your home printer with regular paper.
2. #11 Hobby (Xacto) knife and blade. It does not have to be a name brand, but it should have a #11 blade. These can be purchased at Amazon, Staples, Target, Wal-Mart, and at most hardware stores. If you cannot find a hobby knife, purchase a knife from Jeanette Kuvinoren.com/classes.
3. Piece of cardboard to put under your papercut while you are cutting (or a "self-healing mat" commonly used for craft projects). The cardboard should be thick enough to protect the surface of your table from the blade.
