and His power was proved, His power was proved.

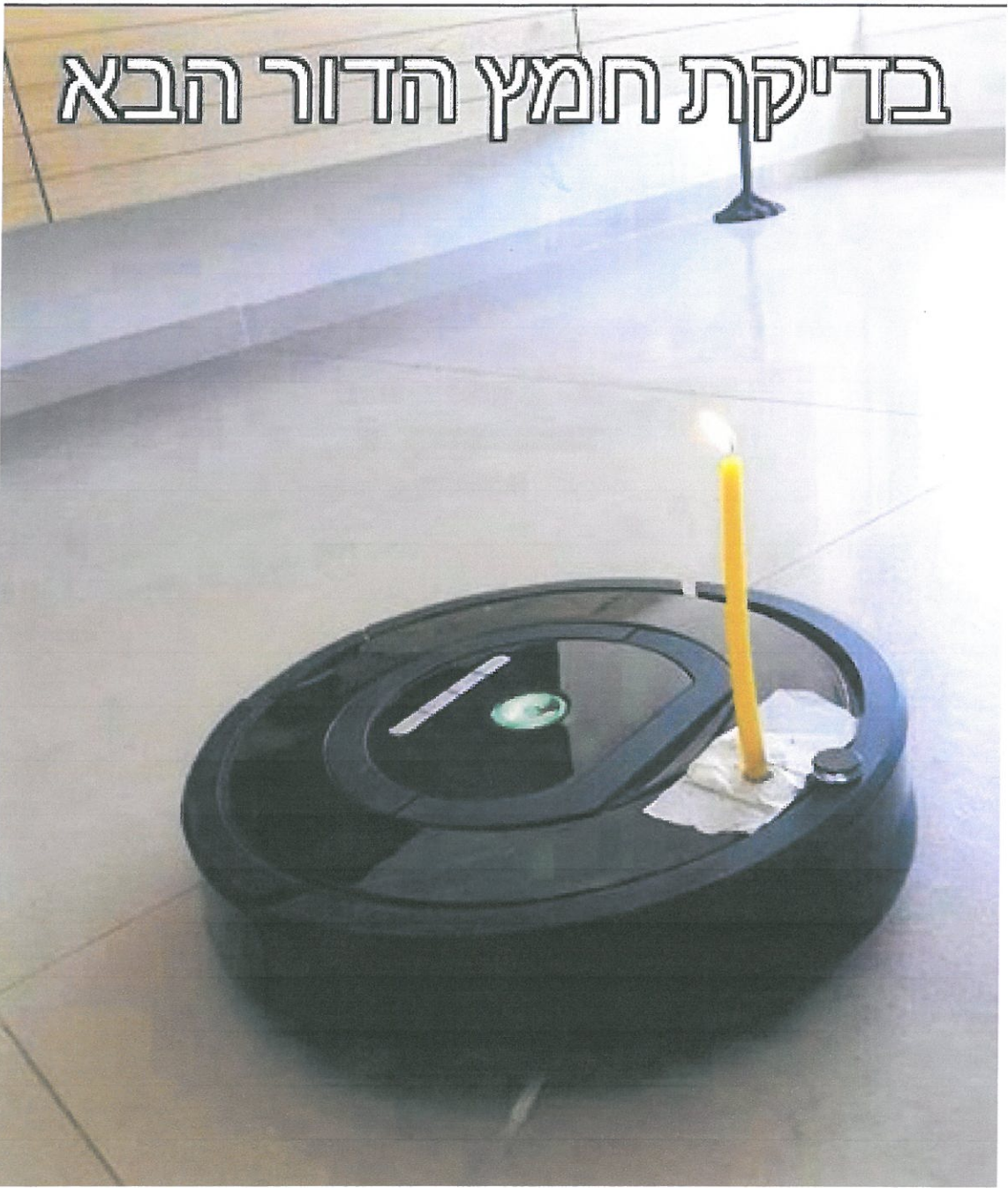
The frogs, the lice, and even boils, could not make Pharoah bend

## Directions for folding your El Al paper airplane

1. Fold plane in half along the middle dotted line with the El Al print visible. This is the fold line that you will use to make your plane.
2. Open paper, and bring corner "A" to edge of fold line on the unprinted side, and make new fold. Repeat with corner "B".
3. Now bring corner "C" to edge of fold line on the unprinted side, and make new fold. Repeat with "D".
4. Lie plane so El Al printed side is face up, and fold corner "E" to the edge of fold line covering up El Al. Repeat with "F".
5. Refold the fold line and pinch the passengers with one hand while you lift up the wings of the plane with your other hand.

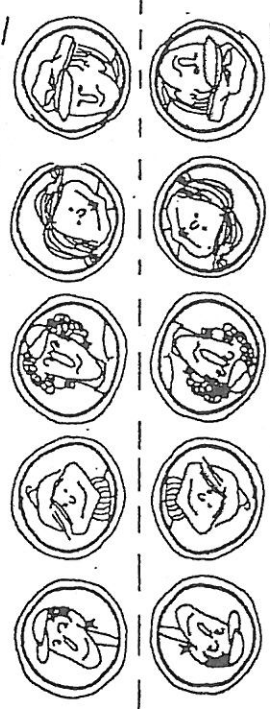
